Post-COVID Benefit Changes

Some of the temporary flexibilities that Medicaid participants received during the COVID-19 pandemic were possible because of federal funding and will end when federal and state COVID-19 public health emergencies (PHE) end.

If you are a Medicaid recipient and received a PINK notice from DHHS, you may need to provide more information or complete a redetermination to see if you are still eligible for Medicaid once the federal PHE ends. The latest HHS extension for the PHE was effective through January 11, 2023.
